Dear Executive Director Zingale,

On behalf of thousands of Florida taxpayers and members of the Florida Institute of Certified Public Accountants (FICPA), I would like to respectfully request your immediate consideration in providing tax relief for those impacted by Hurricane Helene.

Hurricane Helene made landfall as a major Category 4 storm on Sept. 26, 2024, with serious impacts across the state of Florida. We would specifically ask you to consider taking actions to provide relief to those impacted by the storm, such as providing applicable extensions on filing and paying taxes during and after the emergency period, including filing and paying Corporate Income Taxes. Taxpayers and tax professionals are working diligently to comply specifically with state filing deadlines, but many have experienced significant losses and disruption to their businesses. As you know this is the third significant storm to hit this part of the state in less than two years, and the impacts reach far beyond just those counties directly hit. Please note, similar requests and actions have been granted in previous storms.

We greatly appreciate the FICPA and DOR's longstanding working relationship to coordinate these matters on behalf of our members and taxpayers across the state. The FICPA stands ready to assist with coordination of communications to our members. With that in mind, I would ask for your thoughtful consideration of this request.
